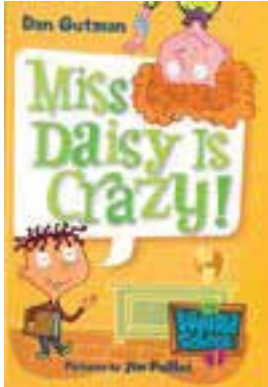

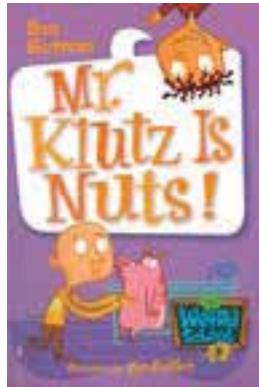

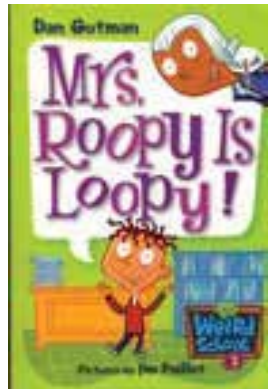
#1: MISS DAISY IS CRAZY!

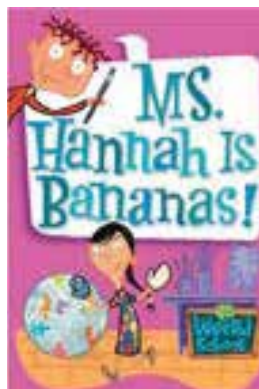
#2: MR. KLUTZ IS NUTS!

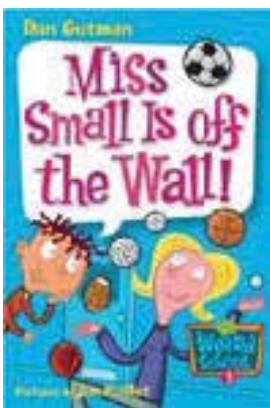
#3: MRS. ROOPY IS LOOPY!

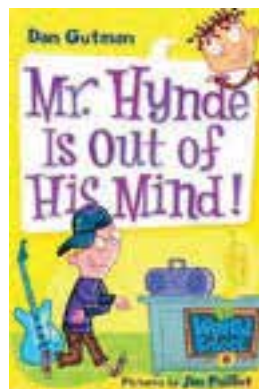
#4: MS. HANNAH IS BANANAS!

Ms. Hannah wears dresses made out of pot holders and collects garbage instead of throwing it out. This is the weirdest art class ever!



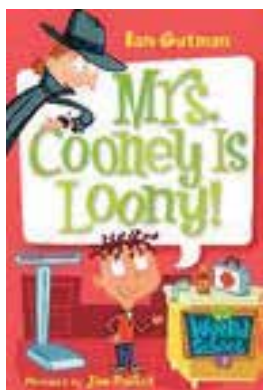
#5: MISS SMALL IS OFF THE WALL!

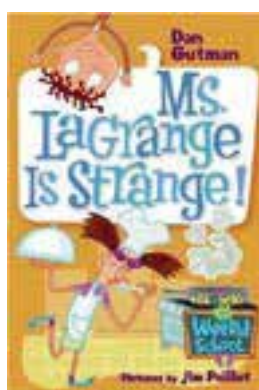
#6: MR. HYNDE IS OUT OF HIS MIND!

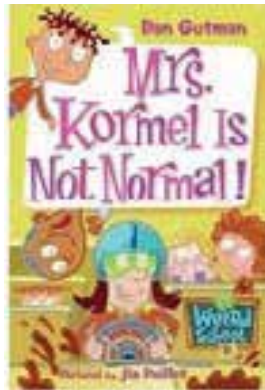
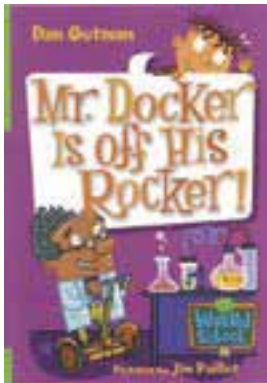


#9: MISS LAZAR IS BIZARRE!

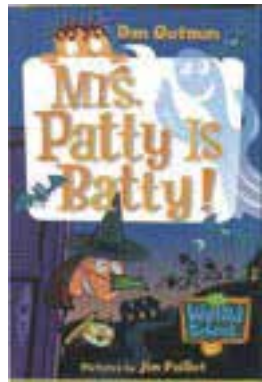
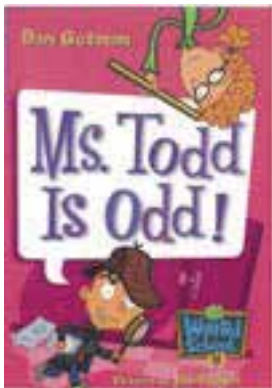


#11: MRS. KORMEL IS NOT NORMAL!

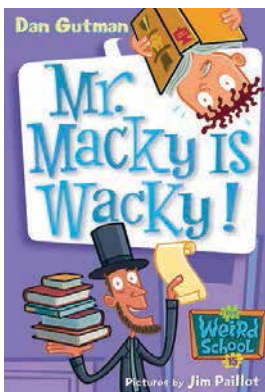
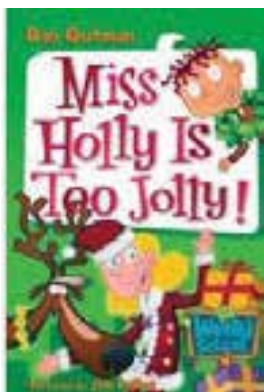


#13: MRS. PATTY IS BATTY!

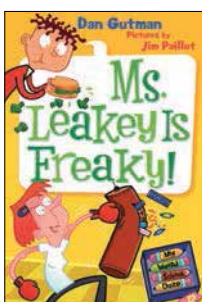
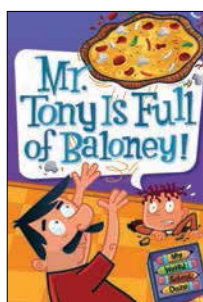
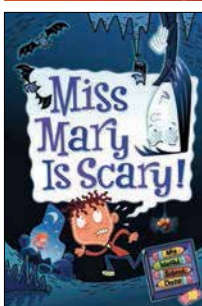
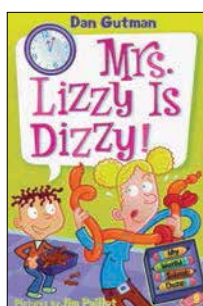
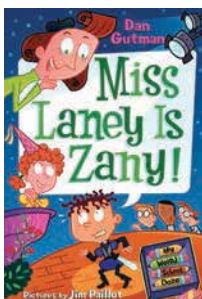
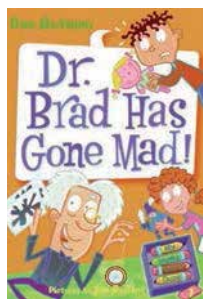
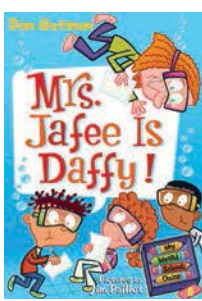
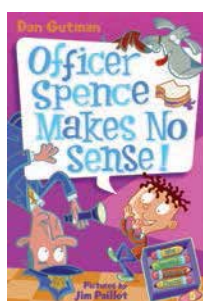
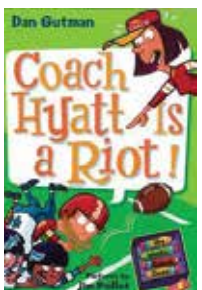
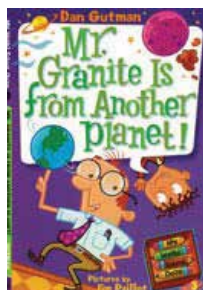
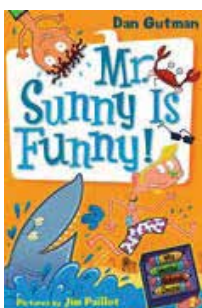
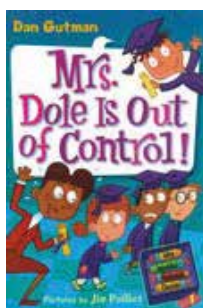
#21: MS. KRUP CRACKS ME UP!

#6: MAYOR HUBBLE IS IN TROUBLE!

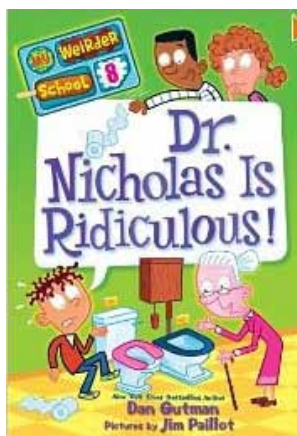
